Last week Mrs Birkinshaw met with Mr O'Toole the Headteacher of Sir John Talbot School in order to strengthen the links between the two schools. This is a summary of our discussions....

- Bronington VA Primary will work with staff at SJT to ensure a smooth transition to High School for our pupils and ensure that information sharing is even better!
- Mr O'Toole confirmed that there is absolutely no issue with the academic standards of our pupils as they leave the Welsh system and move to the English.
- We are going to endeavor to engage with transition activities and SJT have offered to lend us their inflatable planetarium this term to use free of charge.
- The New Head of Maths has been appointed from a Welsh School and understands the Welsh mathematics curriculum really well.

As a school we would like to say well done to a number of our ex pupils. Last term 6 pupils in year 7 who finished at Bronington in 2018 were recognized for their academic progress in a range of subjects at the SJT's prize-giving. These children are now in year 8.

This year 3 pupils in year 7 from Bronington have been chosen, because of their high ability and aptitude in English and Maths to study Latin this year! Congratulations to those pupils - we are very proud of you!
