## World Book Day

## Happy Saint David's Day!

We had a lovely day on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February, celebrating St David's Day. All children participated in folk dancing, singing Welsh songs, art related to the work of a Welsh artist and baking. As ever the children behaved brilliantly and enjoyed sharing their work in an assembly at the end of the day.



## Easter Garden

We would like to make a display of Easter Gardens made by our children. To make your own Easter Garden at home, take a large tray or dish and fill the bottom with small rocks. Place a small clay



flowerpot on its side within the rocks so that they keep the pot secure from rolling around. Then, use potting soil, wet it by mixing it in a bowl with water so that it will pack down. Start mounding the soil over the small pot to form a hill. Next, add some smaller rocks outside the tomb and around the side to make a pathway.

Now, using quick start grass seed, moss, or other quick growing seed, cover the dirt with the seeds and water in well. Finally, use some smaller twigs and place them into the form of a cross and place them on the hill.
